


Christmas Lantern



YOU WILL NEED:

 Colored tissue paper Glitter

Scissors

Wide ribbon


· Glass jar, clean

Night-light or candle

Glue

- 1. Cut tissue paper into squares (about 1 inch by 1 inch).
- **2.** Brush slightly watered-down glue onto the outside of the glass jar starting at the top and doing a small section at a time.
- **3.** Place the tissue paper squares onto the glue, either randomly or in a pattern. Add glitter if you want. Let dry.
- **4.** Add glue to the top of the jar. Wrap the ribbon around the top of the jar and tie in a bow.
- **5.** Place a night-light inside the jar or ask an adult to place a candle inside. Remember to never leave a burning candle unattended!





Pinecone Christmas Tree




YOU WILL NEED:

- •1 large fir pinecone
- Green paint
- Glue
- 1 small terracotta pot that matches the size of your pinecone
- Thick construction paper or thin wooden star
- Glitter
- Ribbon
- **1.** Lay down newspaper to protect your workspace. Paint the pinecone green. Let dry.
- **2.** Drizzle or roll the pinecone in glue.
- 3. Sprinkle or roll the pinecone in glitter. Let dry.
- **4.** Cut a star out of the construction paper or use a thin wooden star from a local craft store. Cover with glue and then cover thickly with glitter. Let dry.
- **5.** Place the pinecone in the pot and glue or place the star at the top.
- **6.** Add glue to the top of the pot. Wrap the ribbon around the top of the pot and tie in a bow. Or make a bow and glue it to only one side of the pot.





Merry Mice



YOU WILL NEED:

- •Red and green felt
- Glue

Scissors

Pom-poms

Googly eyes


Candy canes

Ruler

Tape

- 1. Cut a 6-inch-long, teardrop-shaped body from the red felt. Near the center, cut two parallel lines 1 inch long and about half an inch from each other.
- **2.** For a pair of ears, cut a five-inch-long, round, bow-tie shape from the green felt.
- **3.** To put the mouse together, fit the ears through the slits in the body. Glue on googly eyes and a pom-pom nose.
- **4.** Add a curly tail by slipping a candy cane beneath the mouse and tucking the straight end between the body and the ears to hold it in place.





Sock Snowman



YOU WILL NEED:

White baby sock

Glue

Batting

Permanent marker

String

·Orange pipe cleaner

• Fabric or ribbon

• 2 mini pom-poms

Colored baby sock

- 1. Fill the foot of a white baby sock with batting. Tie shut just above the ankle with string. Trim off the cuff.
- **2.** Divide the sock ball into body and head by tying a piece of fabric or ribbon (scarf) around the sock.
- **3.** To make the hat, gather the colored sock at the ankle and tie with a string. Leave enough string for a hanging loop. Cut off the foot. Roll up the edge of the sock like a stocking cap. Glue or sew on the hat.
- **4.** Next, glue or sew on buttons. Draw on the eyes and mouth with a marker. Cut a one-inch piece of orange pipe cleaner for the nose and poke it in. Glue on pom-poms.
