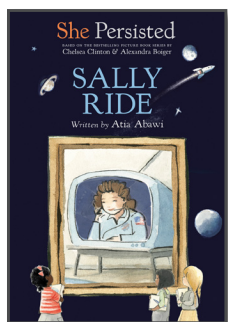

In the web diagram below, write down all of the things that make Ruby a hero to you.

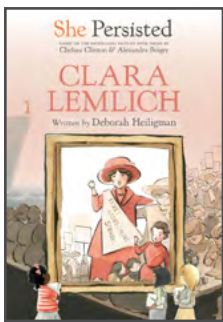
