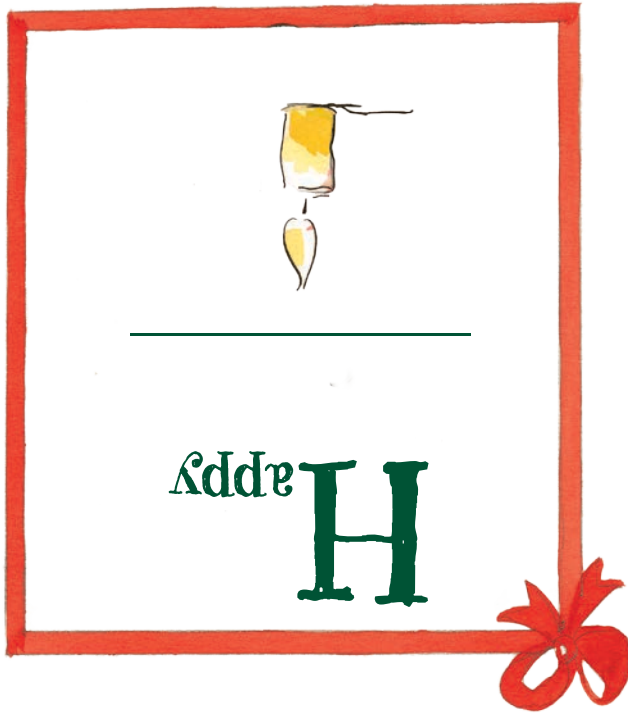


The best part about this card is that you can customize it for any holiday.
