




Beautiful Butterfly - Mariposa Hermosa






Connect the Dots - Une los Puntos

La Araña Muy Ocupada está tejiendo su telarañas. ¿Puedes unir los puntos para ayudarla a terminar?


















Animals Sounds - Sonidos de los Animales






Cake Decorating - Decoración del Pastel










My Very Own Tissue Paper Animal








Can you make your own mini party hat?

Print this page and color and decorate the mini party hat! Then have a grown-up help you cut it out and fold the flap along the dotted line. Roll the hat into a cone shape and, using either glue or tape, attach the flap to the inside of the hat where the edges of the cone meet. Secure the hat to your head with a piece of string that's long enough to go under your chin when fastened to opposite inside edges of the cone.















Can you decorate to celebrate Eric Carle's birthday?

Print multiple copies of the following pages and have a grown-up help you cut out the triangles. Then fold the flaps along the dotted line over a long piece of string and glue or tape them down. Hang your bunting wherever you plan to have your birthday celebration!





















Can you make Very Hungry Caterpillar cake pops?

Have a grown-up help you follow the cake pop recipe directions below. Create your Very Hungry Caterpillar-themed cake pops, set them up in a caterpillar shape, take a pic, and enjoy!

Directions:

For starters, choose a cake mix that's your favorite—vanilla, chocolate, red velvet—it's your choice! Then make sure you also have white frosting along with red and green food dye. Finally, we're going to decorate Caterpillar's head with long purple sprinkles and green frosting gel for his face and antennae (these last ingredients are optional if you want to go with a simpler design).

Steps:

- I. Mix and roll. Crumble the cooled cake in a large bowl. Then add a few spoonful's of frosting and use your hands to combine. The dough should hold together if squeezed. If it's still crumbly, stir in a little more frosting. Then scoop out the mixture with a medium cookie scoop and roll into a ball. Repeat until you've used all of the mixture.
- 2. Add cake pop stick. Melt white chocolate wafers in two separate bowls. Add enough the red food coloring to one bowl and green into the other and mix until you get the colors you like. Then dip the end of the cake pop stick (lollipop sticks) into the melted chocolate and push that same end into the cake ball. The melted chocolate helps "glue" the stick to the cake ball. Once each ball has a stick, place them in the freezer to harden for about 20 minutes.
- 3. Coat in chocolate. Dip the cake balls into the melted red and green chocolate, making sure it's fully coated. Gently tap the stick on the side of the dish to remove any excess chocolate. Make sure you do more green cake balls than red for the caterpillar's body. To make Caterpillar's body, you'll need six green cake pops one red cake pop for his head!
- 4. Add decorations. Add the long sprinkles for Caterpillar's antennae on the red cake pop while the chocolate is still wet. If decorating with a frosting gel, let the chocolate coating harden first, then decorate Caterpillar's face. Let the cake balls set for about an hour before serving.
- 5. Assemble your Very Hungry Caterpillar!
 Put your decorated cake pops together
 to make the shape of the Very Hungry
 Caterpillar. Snap a pic and enjoy!
